NASA plans to deal with the asteroid-killer, destroying the world, the first people to know about it, most likely, learn through a text message. Seriously. If a killer asteroid were discovered on its way to hitting Earth, the first word about its existence would most likely come in the form of text or e-mail - preliminary information about the space rock sent to a group of fewer than 12 scientists. At this stage, the researchers wouldn't know much about the size and trajectory of the errant space rock, but that would quickly change. They would have been hastily collecting observations of an object, probably first spotted by one of the large observation telescopes, constantly looking out for such things. And then, they'd come to work. There is a small but very real possibility that one day an asteroid that is leveling the city (or even destroying the planet) could hit the planet. A major asteroid impact can cause wide swaths of regional damage, everything from broken windows to toppled buildings, a disaster that can range from a local tragedy to a global event. And while the probability that an asteroid to hit Earth is extremely low (an asteroid 5,000 feet high is expected to hit Earth only about once every 1 million years), NASA, in fact, has a plan of action, in case the errant space rock has passed us. If a newfound object really looks like it's on a course that will take it to Earth in the next six days, the Small Planet Center system sends an automatic text message or email to a select group of people at the center and NASA. This, explained NASA Planetary Defense Officer Lindley Johnson, when they receive a warning about any possibility that the new discovery could be on the impact trajectory, he explained to Mashable in an interview. Seeing asteroids, killer or no alert can come out a flurry of follow-up observations. After the journal, amateur astronomers and people using large telescopes can train their own instruments on parts of the sky to gather more data on a possible object while trying to its size and orbit. Usually... when we get further observations, the possibility of a strike disappears or the possibility of a very close approach disappears, Gareth Williams, Deputy Director The Small Planet Center said. As it turned out, the Earth is not so big from the goal. And although there are many asteroids, a relatively large asteroid very rarely enters our atmosphere. If an asteroid actually looks like it has a chance to hit the planet, however, NASA notifies the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy, and then shortly thereafter, issues a press release to inform the public. NASA and the Small Center of the Planet must come to an agreement on whether any given space rock will hit the planet before they go wide with a statement on NEO, Williams said. Because of this caution, you will probably hear about the possibility of a collision with an asteroid before any press release from NASA. Because the work is done in the open, surveillance and orbits are available over the Internet if you know where to look, Johnson explained. People on the internet will probably talk about it before we get to the point where we can put a public notice out. Since all orbital maps, trajectories and coordinates are already available to scientists around the world, inevitably there will be chatter about it on Twitter, Reddit, and all the other usual suspect-forums before the official announcement of the asteroid course collision is made. NASA is also monitoring the future of Earth. The space agency plans expected orbits for each NEO found to give or take about 100 years in the future in order to see if space rocks can make any close brushes with our planet, at any time. How to move an asteroid Scientists have mapped an orbit of about 90 percent of the NEO about 1 kilometer or more, and they hope to map that percentage of objects 140 meters or more. This kind of orbital mapping is more than scientifically interesting. Scientists want as much time as possible to help protect Earth from the worst effects of an asteroid impact. NASA is also exploring ways to deflect an asteroid if it approaches our planet. Engineers have floated everything from firing lasers to an asteroid to going full armageddon (and yes, actually blowing it up) as ideas that could help distract it. Although nothing has been tested in space yet, theoretically, these devices can keep the Earth safe by pushing rogue asteroids or comets aside. NASA and the European Space Agency are collaborating on a new concept mission called Asteroid Impact and Deflection Assessment (AIDA), which will test whether an asteroid can be moved by a shock. If it works, this method can be used to help distract the actual NEO if dangerous approach to our planet. But now we just have to watch the sky, wait and hope for the best. FEMA has hired 7,474 people to work in Washington, D.C., regional offices, emergency training centers and other offices. Most jobs are civil service appointments and are highly competitive. There are appointments full-time and for people who respond only when needed. Both of these types of jobs are for two or four years and they can be extended by a year if the government has funding and if there is a need for a post. Young people between the ages of 18 and 24 can apply for positions at FEMACorps, which is similar to the Peace Corps, but for internal action. It is a division of AmeriCorps and positions for ten months, full-time. Some of these young people are working with fema's permanent staff on disaster preparedness and relief. Jobs can be extended for another year of service. Recent jobs available at FEMA included emergency management oversight, with salaries ranging from \$75,902 to \$88,155. The post was appointed for four years. A specialist in emergency management recovery earned \$51,837 to \$67,378. This post has been for two years. Another appointment, which was scheduled for a two-year period, was assigned to a hazardous materials specialist. Compensation for this work was an hourly wage of \$16.30 to \$24.41.
